Journey of Education in India – Part 2

From the Gurukuls to the Classroom Schools; the British era saw a major transformation in the way of providing education.

In the 19th Century, with the renewal of the East India Company's Charter, the firm principally took over the educational affairs in India along with its corporate interests. Thus, a system was set up by Thomas Macaulay where the Indians were accommodated with English curriculum with the intention of making them the mediator between the British and the Indians.

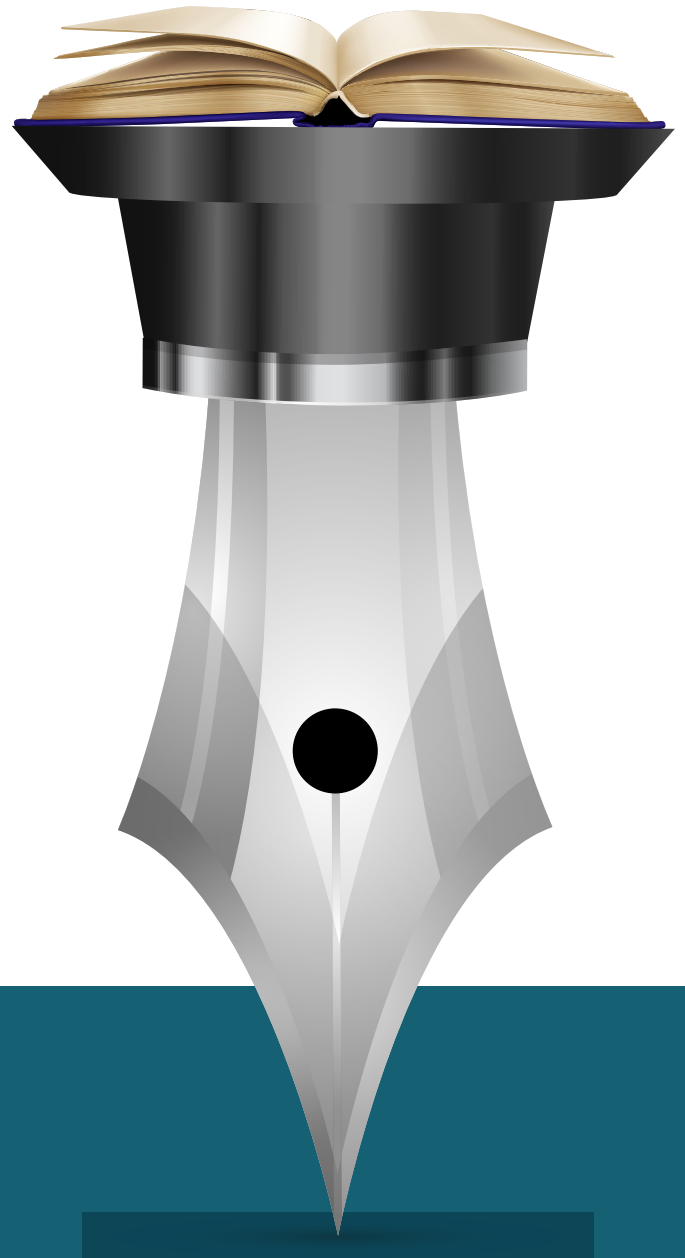
Macaulay succeeded in replacing the regional languages in the education system with that of English, making it the primary language. By consequence of the English Education Act of 1835, English served as the administrative language, the medium of instruction, and a source language for teachers training. This act was brought in effect by Lord William Bentinck.

As the time went by, the western curriculum was deeply integrated in the Indian Education System. And in the late 19th century and start of 20th century, many wealthy personnels of India opted for higher education at England in the field of Law and Liberal Arts. Some of the personalities were Mahatma Gandhi, Jawaharlal Nehru and many more.

At present, India is the 2nd largest country in the world with the English-speaking population. This education system continues till date in many parts of the country.

CHANDRAYAAN 3

Empowering the nation in the field of Space Exploration, Chandrayaan 3 is an impeccable mission successfully executed by Indian Space Research Organisation. The spacecraft was launched on 14th July 2023 from Satish Dhawan Space Centre.

The Spacecraft consists of three components: the propulsion module, lander and a rover. The objective of the mission was to demonstrate safe and soft landing on the lunar surface and conduct in-situ scientific experiments. The spacecraft successfully landed on the south-pole of moon on 23rd August 2023.

Sun is a major component of the solar system which bind the planets together. To study this phenomenal star of the solar system, ISRO planned an exceptional mission of solar observation. This mission consists of a coronagraph spacecraft on a PSLV-C57 rocket launched successfully on 2nd September 2023.

This space-based mission is executed to study the solar atmospheric dynamics, elements of space weather, corona heating, propagation of particle and fields along with flare activities and their characteristics. The Spacecraft destination is the Lagrange Point of Sun-Earth System and it is scheduled to reach there in January 2024.
