

WISDOM WAVES



Poems, as an art form describes the major ideologies in a simple manner. The word flow, the rhyme scheme and the theme makes us wander in the literary ocean with emotional tides. There have been many such poets who display their talents ferociously and one among them is **D. R. Bendre.**

Born on 31st January 1896, Dattatreya Ramachandra Bendre was the greatest Kannada Lyric Poet of the 20th century. His works are mainly in the North Kannada Dialect giving the words a sway of musicality and euphony. He has also been conferred with many titles such as 'Varakavi' – the Gifted Poet, Kavikula Tilaka – A Jewel among the Poets and Kavya Garudiga – a Sorcerer Poet. The literary composition encompasses his valuable knowledge of Quantum Physics, Mathematics and Human Physiology.

He used the pen name 'Ambikatanayadatta' which literally translates to 'Datta, Son of Ambika', yet described by D.R. Bendre as his 'Universal Inner Voice' that dictates his poems and literary work. He is a recipient of Jnanapita Prashasti – the highest literary award in 1973 for his poem collection 'Naaku Tanti' (Four Strings) published in 1964. He also received Padma Shri in 1968 and Sahitya Akademi Award in 1969.

He took his last breath on 26^{th} October 1981 aged 85 at Mumbai. His unique style of composition and literary work displays his brilliance and excellence in the art form that travels beyond generations and transforms humanity.


