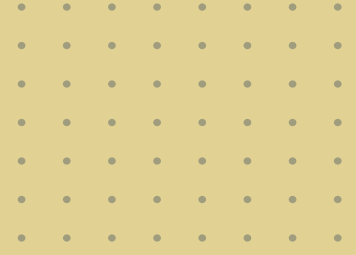

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WISDOM WAVES

*Diving into the Artistic Realm!!*

Meet the Great Kannada Poet of the 20th Century, Shri Kuppalli Venkatappa Puttappa, born on 29th December 1904. He was a literary genius and also the initiator of the Kannada Language as a medium of study in Karnataka.

This individual was a creator of infinite literature works under the name 'Kuvempu' that comprises Kaanuru Heggaditi – a Novel; Kolalu – A Collection of Poems; Shoodra Tapasvi – a Play; and many more. His adaptation of the Ramayana, 'Sri Ramayana Darshanam' brought him to the limelight and made him the absolute recipient of the Jnanpith Award in 1967 – the first Kannada writer to ever do so.

Identifying the literary contribution, the Government of India honoured the creative persona with Padma Bhushan in 1958 and Padma Vibhushan in 1988. The Government of Karnataka also honoured the artist with the honorific 'Rastrakavi', a National Poet in 1964 and Karnataka Ratna in 1992. GoK also adopted one of his poems, 'Jaya Bharata Jananiya Tanujate', as the state anthem.

The lifespan of the great poet concluded on 11th November 1994. However, his marvellous creations in terms of literature have inspired the lives of contemporary artists ever since.

Creya Showcase

On 6th January 2024, the Creya Showcase was organised at Nagarjuna Vidyaniketan. True to its meaning, Creya imparts learning through immersive and experiential methodology.

- i. Grades 1 and 2 students conversed with guests about their awareness of environmentally friendly settings.
- ii. Grade 3 students came up with a smart city design using basic structures equipped with cantilever, arches which can be varied by joining two cantilevers of varying length and breadth. Hence, the structures included:
 - Bridges made by putting together several arches.

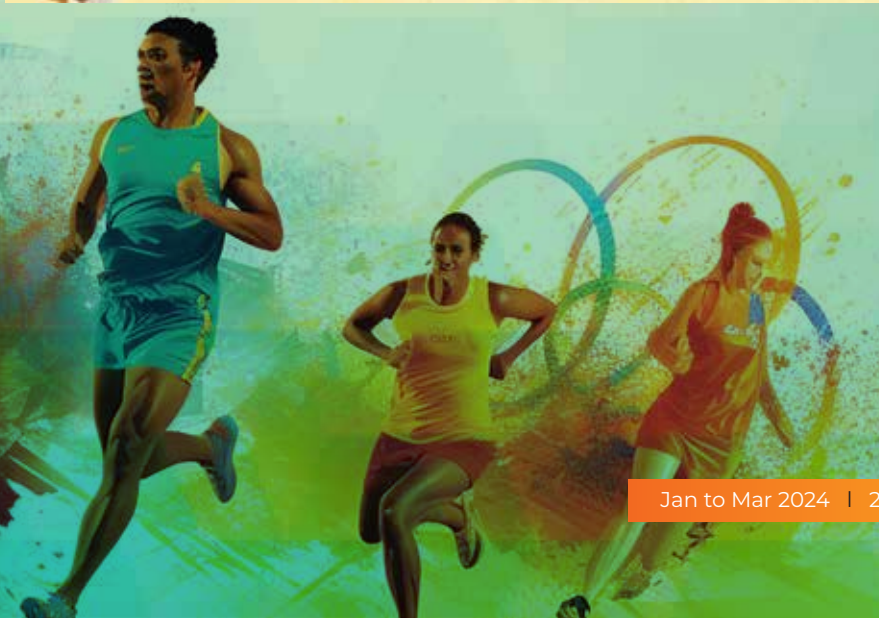


Nagarjuna Sports Meet 2024
