

K. Shivaram Karanth

Demonstrating worlds through words.

Developing a idea into a distinct universe with its characters, situations, and storyline is the extraordinary talent of the writers. Mr. K Shivaram Karanth is one such storyteller of Karnataka who bestows deep wisdom through simple narratives.

Born on 10th October 1902, this literary genius was an Indian polymath who contributed to society as a novelist, playwright, and ecological conservationist. He began his writing journey in the year 1924 with his first book, 'Rashtrageetha Sudhakara'—a Collection of Poems—and 'Vichitrakoota'—his first novel. Later on, Ramachandra Guha acknowledged "Rabindranath Tagore of Modern India—who has been one of the finest novelists-activists Independence." He also earned the nickname "Kadala Theerada Bhargava."

His phenomenal artwork comprised 47 novels, 31 plays, 13 art books, 9 encyclopaedias, 6 essay and sketchbooks, 4 short story collections, and 2 volumes poems. 'Devadhutaru', a 1928 satire on contemporary India, stands out as his most notable work among these. Additionally, the 1968 publication "Mookajji Kanasugalu" addressed the nation's customs and beliefs through the lens of the younger generation. This novel secured him a Jnanpith Award in 1977.

Additionally, he received the Padma Bhushan in 1968, but he returned the medal in protest to India's emergency. He took his last breath on 9th December 1997 at Manipal while leaving behind a legacy of wonderful stories that take you through different realms.






e. EMMVEE Solar Systems Pvt. Limited.
